The petitioners filed a writ petition seeking a direction for restoration of ad-hoc relief which was granted to them by the Government of Haryana. The writ petition was disposed of on 14.5.2019 directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 16.1.2019. The needful was to be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The petitioners sent a notice through registered post on 16.11.2019. There is no proof to show as to when certified copy was received by the respondents.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Mr. Sandeep S. Mann, Senior DAG, Haryana who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

The contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to do the needful for compliance of the order dated 14.5.2019

within three months from today. In case the directions are not complied with even in the time now extended, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official(s) personally.
