Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.226 dated 05.09.2018 under Sections 379-B, 452, 411 IPC, registered at Police Station City, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner along with co-accused Balwinder Kaur entered the house of the complainant and had taken away some articles by giving threat to her life. It is further submitted that even co-accused Balwinder Kaur has already been granted the concession of regular bail by the trial Court vide order dated 10.10.2018. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is first offender; he is in custody for the last 06 months and 11 days; recovery has already been effected and conclusion of the trial will take some time.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate dated

26.03.2019 filed in the Court today, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything further on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
