Petitioner Gajendra Singh Shekhawat has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.242 dated 08.12.2017, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

The allegation levelled against the petitioner is that the wife of the petitioner was found in burning condition in his house. After investigation, the offence under Section 306 IPC was made out.

The trial is in progress. As per postmortem report, the deceased suffered about 16 injuries on different parts of her body.

Keeping in view the seriousness of the offence, this court is of

the view that the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of regular bail.

Therefore, the instant petition stands dismissed.
