The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.0111, dated 25.07.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in FIR are that he along with co-accused had snatched ₹ 40,000/- from the complainant. He, however, contends that the petitioner is a worker in liquor vend and has been falsely implicated in the case. He is in custody since 20.09.2018.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from Head Constable Satbir Singh states that 03 out of 12 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially, when the petitioner is in custody for over 8 months and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the

petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
