The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 14.3.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 354-A, 109, 34 of Indian Penal Code, (Sections 354, 498-A of IPC added later on) at Police Station Chheherata, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Heard.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Balwinder Masih states that notice has been issued to respondent No.2 but none has put in appearance. He further on his instructions states that a compromise has been effected between the parties and the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this

- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
