Petitioner prays for grant of interim bail for a period of two weeks to attend his daughter's marriage.

Petitioner is accused in FIR No.104, dated 06.08.2019, registered under Sections 15/18/22/25 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

The Special Court after considering various aspects of the case has ordered as under:-

“As per report of SHO, PS Amloh and statements of Sarpanch and other respectables of village Rurki, the marriage of daughter of present accused Mukand Khan is going to be solemnized on 01.01.2020. The purpose of filing the bail application has been affirmed by recording the statements of SHO as well as inhabitants of the village. In the present set of circumstances, propriety demands the accused should be allowed to attend the marriage ceremony of his daughter with the condition that Jail Superintendent shall depute Special Escort under custody to take the applicant to attend the marriage function of his daughter at village Rurki on 01.01.2020 from 08:00 am to 05:00 p.m and the expenses of the special escort so deputed shall be borne by the applicant himself. With these observation, interim bail for one day only as per prescribed time by the applicant stands allowed. Papers be attached with the main file. Copy of this order be also sent to Jail Superintendent.

A bare look at the invitation card, it is apparent that “Barat” is to reach at 09:00 AM on 01.01.2020, whereas time for 'Nikaah” is stated 12.00 Noon and the 'Doli' is to leave at 04:00 PM. The Special Court has already shown indulgence by permitting the petitioner to attend the marriage function from 08.00 AM to 05:00 PM.

In view thereof, this court does not find any ground to grant further relief as prayed for.

Hence, dismissed.
