Separate reply by way of affidavit of Vijay Kumar Gill, Executive Engineer, Intensive Investigation Division, Hoshiarpur and affidavit of Vikant Anand, Executive Engineer, Janauri Chohal Construction Division, Hoshiarpur filed in Court are taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner(s). As per the said replies, the order has been complied with and the bills have been cleared.
