[1] The petitioner, who claims that he was appointed as Medical Officer in August, 2003 by the Government of Haryana proceeded on leave from the Department on 05th /06th May, 2015, purportedly on account of family circumstances and did not join thereafter. Plea is that on account of his domestic condition having improved, he wants to rejoin service, for which he submitted an application dated 31.05.2017 through proper channel to the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, praying for being allowed to rejoin service, but no action has been taken on the same.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the representation (Annexure P-1) dated 31.05.2017, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner. No particulars have been given with regard to the action taken by the respondents on account of the petitioner having proceeded on leave on 05th /06th May, 2015 and not rejoining thereafter

for a number of years. In any case, the application for permission to rejoin is also dated 31.05.2017.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief prayed for, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-1) dated 31.05.2017, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter.
