[1] Learned counsel contends that the petitioner had applied for the post of JBT Teacher and was selected for the same, whereafter the petitioner completed the formalities for appointment and although all formalities have been completed in terms of orders of Hon'ble the Division Bench in LPA No.686 of 2016 dated 08.05.2017, appointment letter has not been issued, till date, despite the petitioner having served representation followed by legal notice (Annexure P-4) dated 08.11.2019.

[2] Learned counsel states that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-4) dated 08.11.2019, in a time bound manner.

[3] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as is made in the legal notice (Anneuxre P-4) dated 08.11.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
