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**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J.(ORAL)**

The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.413 dated 29.07.2016 under Sections 406, 409 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Gohana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the dispute between the complainant and petitioners primarily is civil in nature and with regard to dealership of Prachi Gas which is owned by the petitioners. He also contends that the matter has now been compromised with the complainant.

Learned State counsel states that challan has been filed but no witness has been examined.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners, especially when the petitioners have compromised the matter, investigation has been completed and the conclusion of the

trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
