The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members from the hands of the respondents No. 4 & 5.

Although, the grievance of the petitioner, in substance, appears to be some dispute regarding the property, however, the petitioner has also raised concern about her life and liberty. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to assess the threat perception to the petitioner and to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

However, it is further clarified that the present order shall not be made a basis for any other action against the respondents No.4 & 5, which legally may not be called for against them.

The petition stands disposed off with the above directions.
