[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for adjustment as Extension Lecturer under the Policy of Adjustment (Annexure P-5) dated 28.01.2019 as Assistant Professor/Extension Lecturer (Mathematics).

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-6) dated 04.10.2019 in respect of the grievance, which is the subject matter of the instant writ petition, but the same has not been decided, till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-6) dated 04.10.2019, in accordance with law.

[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

[5] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-6) dated 04.10.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
