The petitioner alleges that a complaint dated 12.07.2019 had been submitted to the concerned police station for registration of an FIR against the persons named as accused therein who have allegedly cheated the petitioner to the tune of Rs. 14,30,000/-. The complaint was marked to one DSP Gurdeep Singh CAP Hoshiarpur but it is alleged that the said officer is colluding with the accused persons.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 and 5 only.

Mr. Prabhjot Singh Walia, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and 5. Let five copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to serve the private respondents or to seek reply from the official respondents.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No. 3 to objectively consider the representation dated 05.12.2019 (Annexure P-2) and to take appropriate action thereupon in accordance with law, in case it is found

necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
