The petitioners challenge order dated 06.11.2019 (Annexure P-5) as well as order dated 04.12.2019 (Annexure P-7) passed by the learned Appellate Court, whereby non-bailable warrants of arrest have been issued against the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were acquitted by the trial Court and in appeal, they have been summoned. They were appearing regularly on all dates, but could not do so on 06.11.2019 as a wrong date had been noted. The learned Appellate Court has issued non-bailable warrants of arrest against the petitioners. The petitioners undertake not to absent themselves in future.

4. Mr. Parveen Kumar Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts the notice on behalf of the State-respondent No.1. Let two copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

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5. Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to serve the private respondent or to seek a reply from any one of the respondents.
6. The petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to surrender before the learned Appellate Court on or before 30.01.2020. In case, such an application is filed, the same shall be allowed.
