HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

Counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pension) Part-I Rules, 2009 (Annexure P/3), the petitioner was entitled for revision of her basic pension after attaining the age of 85 years, 90 years and 95 years, which benefit has not been extended to her despite the fact that she was fully entitled for the same. The prayer of the petitioner is for revising her pension in pursuance to Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pension) Part-I Rules, 2009 (Annexure P/3).

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which is being claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with legal notices dated 09.08.2019 and 11.08.2019 (Annexures P/4 and P/5) respectively which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notices.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notices dated 09.08.2019 and 11.08.2019 (Annexure P/4 and P/5) respectively by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to her within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
