The present petition was filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to seek protection from private respondents as they had entered into a marriage in pursuance to love affairs between them, against the wishes of the parents of the girl.

This Court on 13.09.2018, disposed of the petition by directing the Senior Superintendent of Police to look into the representation of the petitioners and take necessary action, if so required. At the same time, it was ordered that a sum of ₹5 lacs be deposited by petitioner No.1 in the shape of FDR in favour of the second petitioner within a period of 3 months. Since the compliance of the order regarding deposit of the amount was not made, therefore, the matter was listed again for hearing.

Notice was issued to the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and subsequently, bailable warrants were issued to secure presence of the petitioners. Petitioner No.2 is represented by Mr. K.S. Kahlon, Advocate, who has contended that the requisite amount was not deposited by petitioner No.1. However, he has apprised this Court that petitioner Nos.1 and 2 have separated

w.e.f. April 2019 and since then, they are living separately. Therefore, the order dated 13.09.2018 is recalled.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed.

The IOIN-CRM-M-40388 of 2018 stands disposed off.
