This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 sub Sections (1)(c) and 2(c) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents/State to grant parole to the petitioner for a period of six weeks to enable him to do agriculture work on the land owned by him & his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-The District Magistrate, Kaithal to consider and decide the application dated 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-1) expeditiously.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- The District Magistrate, Kaithal to consider and decide the application dated 16.08.2019 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law within four weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioner is admissible, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him within four weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the request made by the petitioner is not admissible, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
