This is application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. filed by the petitioners for clubbing the present petition with CRM-M-31556-2018, CRM-M-32183-2018 and CRM-M-32049-2018.

As per the status report of the cases, CRM-M-32049-2018 stands dismissed as withdrawn on 25.01.2019 and CRM-M-32183-2018 is fixed for 04.11.2019 before some other Bench.

For reasons mentioned in the application, which is accompanied by the affidavit, the same is partly allowed. Accordingly, CRM-M-31556-2018 and the present petition are ordered to be clubbed together.

These petitions under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure have been filed for quashing of FIR No.180 dated 24.12.2015 registered under Sections 120-B, 384, 500 & 501 IPC and Section 67 of

Information & Technology Act 2000 and FIR No.104 dated 14.07.2015 registered under Sections 295 IPC at Police Station Division No.2, District Ludhiana City and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 10.05.2016 (Annexure P-2).

There is no representation on behalf of the private parties.

Earlier, the parties were directed to get their statements recorded qua the compromise between them; as was prayed by the petitioners. However, the report has been received from the court below to the effect that none of the parties appeared before the said court to make their statement qua the said compromise.

In view of the above, it is clear that there is no compromise between the parties. Hence, finding no ground to interfere in the matter, the present petitions are dismissed.
