[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to fill up the 04 posts of Junior Engineer (Electrical) reserved in favour of Special Backward Class (SBC) from the General Category candidates.

[2] Learned counsel states that the petitioner has served representation (Annexure P-10) dated 08.07.2019 in respect of the claim, which is the subject matter of the writ petition but the same has not been decided, till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-10) dated 08.07.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

[3] Notice of motion.

[4] Mr. Harish Rathee, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

[5] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-10) dated 08.07.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
