Main cases

This order will dispose of two contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos.1845 of 2018 and 3561 of 2017, as common questions of law and facts are involved therein.

It is not disputed that the amount due to the petitioners in pursuance to the order passed by this Court on 6.10.2016 has been paid from the date of passing of the order i.e. 6.10.2016.

In view of the above, the present contempt petitions are dismissed.

Rules issued against the respondent stands discharged.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the said order has not been fully complied with as they were required to pay the arrears towards medical allowance from the date of the retirement, which has not been done.

However, a perusal of the order does not mention the date from which it has to be granted. Thus, this Court cannot hold the respondent guilty of willful contempt. However, the petitioners will be at liberty to seek clarification or avail the remedy as available to them.
