Petitioner was working as Assistant Professor in the Subject of Commerce with respondent No.3-college on contract basis since 2016. She was relieved in the year 2018 pursuant to the impugned advertisement (Annexure P-8).

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.3 and 6 states that the petitioner had participated in the selection process pursuant to the advertisement (Annexure P-8) and proceedings of the Selection Committee along with criteria has been placed on record as Annexure R-3/7. As per merit, the petitioner is shown at serial No.18. She has secured 55.8 marks.

Last candidate selected has secured 56.4 marks. He further states that as far

as the selection process is concerned, if the petitioner has any grievance, she

can challenge the same before the Education Tribunal. As far as payment of summer vacation salary is concerned, same shall be paid to her within a period of four weeks.

In view of the said fact, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to respondent Nos.3 and 6 to make/release payment of salary to the petitioner for the summer vacations (2016 to 2018) within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Compliance report thereof be sent to this Court. With regard to the dispute of advertisement (Annexure P-8) as well as selection process, petitioner can avail alternative remedy by approaching concerned Educational Tribunal in view of the judgment passed by Division Bench of this Court in **Management of S.D. Model Senior Secondary School & another vs. District Judge-cum-Service Tribunal and another**, CR No.4315 of 2012, (decided on 27.11.2013).
