Petitioners herein seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioners as SPOs as qualifying service for all intents and purposes, including grant of all service benefits and pensionary benefits as per the Judgment dated 15.02.2018 rendered by this Court contained at Annexure P-6.

2. In the premise, petitioners also caused issuance of a legal notice dated 10.07.2019, contained at Anenxure P-10, but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Ms.Monica Chhibber Sharma, Sr.DAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 10.07.2019 contained at Anenxure P-10, and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and Judgement *ibid*, and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
