Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0208 dated 09.10.2018, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 365, 379-B, 506 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 20.12.2018 :-

“Heard.

It is contended that parties have effected the compromise and they have already filed the quashing petition, in which statements of the parties are ordered to be recorded vide order passed by this Court dated 28.11.2018 in CRM-M-49784-2018 titled as Jasmer @ Kala and others vs. State of Haryana and another.

Notice of motion for 28.1.2019.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Ramesh Kumar Ambavta, AAG, Haryana present in Court, accepts notice and seeks time to get instructions.

A copy of the complete paperbook be handed over to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and disclose all the facts to the police. In the event of his arrest, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to the compliance of the conditions contained under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Shri Bhagwan has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case. He has also submitted that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioners.

In view of above, the interim order dated 20.12.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
