The afore-mentioned petitions are being disposed of by common order, as similar issue is involved. For convenience, the facts are being taken from COCP No. 4285 of 2019.

The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking direction to the respondents to pay salary and other consequential benefits on account of duties performed on Saturdays or other holidays. The petition was disposed of on 28.05.2019 directing the respondents to decide the representation. The needful was to be done within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Present petition is filed pleading that needful is not done.
