ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.22 dated 01.04.2017, under Sections 302, 307, 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) and Section 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Valtaha, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR and were named as accused only on the basis of supplementary statement of the complainant recorded on 24.04.2017 after 23 days of the occurrence. They have been found innocent during investigation and have been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 19.12.2018, had granted interim order in the same terms as in CRM-M-50275-2018 and had directed the petitioners to surrender before the trial Court and on their doing so, they were ordered to be released on interim bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sahab Singh, states that the petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court and have been released on interim bail.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have surrendered before the trial Court, the order dated 19.12.2018 is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
