This petition was filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(d) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners Temporary Release Act, 1962 for grant of emergency parole for 6 weeks to the petitioner to attend the Barsi ceremony of his father Vishnu Dutt Verma.

On 23.12.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Present criminal writ petition has been filed by petitioner-Aman Verma, inter alia, invoking provisions of Section 3 (1) (d) of Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners Temporary Release Act, 1962 for grant of emergency parole for 6 weeks to the petitioner, to attend the 'Barsi' ceremony of his deceased father Vishnu Dutt Verma, which is to be held on 27.12.2019.

On 20.12.2019, notice of motion was issued for 23.12.2019.

Mr. Kuldeep Sharma, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, appears and submits that the reply is incomplete.

Learned State counsel is directed to find out and inform the Court regarding the correct factual position of 'Barsi' to be

held on 27.12.2019. He is also directed to ensure that the reply, if any, and the above information is collected and submitted to this Court on 26.12.2019.”

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Vishal Chibber, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala, on behalf of the State. It is mentioned in the reply that Barsi Ceremony of Vishnu Dutt Verma (father of the petitioner), scheduled for 27.12.2019, already stands called off for some other reasons.

In view of the reply filed by the State, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
