[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to appoint the petitioners as per the Sports Policy-2013, Annexure P-1 dated 20.08.2013 as well as Sports Policy-2014, Annexure P-2 dated 15.07.2014 by making out of turn appointment as well as granting cash reward on account of the petitioners being players of international repute in the field of Kabaddi and on account of having secured 2nd position in the 3rd Asian Kabaddi Championship (Circle) 2016 held in Pakistan.

[2] Learned counsel contended that the petitioners have already served legal notice, Annexure P-7 dated 24.09.2019 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the instant writ petition but no action has been taken in respect thereto till date and at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the legal notice, Annexure P-7 dated 24.09.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[3] Mr. Harish Rathee, Learned Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioners.

[4] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioners to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice, Annexure P-7 dated 24.09.2019 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter including the decision, Annexure P-6 passed in LPA No.182 of 2017 on 03.05.2017 in case the same is applicable within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
