1. Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as Class-IV employee in terms of policy dated 01.04.1993/07.03.1996 or 01.10.2003 or w.e.f. the date the benefit has been granted to number of similarly situated juniors of the petitioners.
2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has served legal notice Annexure P/10 dated 15.08.2019, on the respondents, in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the instant writ petition but the same has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide legal notice Annexure P/10 dated 15.08.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion. Mr. Harish Rathee, Sr. DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and states that claim of the petitioner for regularization is highly belated since the claim is based on policy dated 01.04.1993/07.03.1996 or 01.10.2003 or w.e.f. the date when such benefit was granted to the juniors of the petitioner.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide legal notice Annexure P/10 dated 15.08.2019, in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
