HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner has filed the present petition, inter-alia, challenging the order dated 25.11.2019 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Gurdaspur, whereby he has been declared as Proclaimed Offender.

Petitioner is accused in Complaint bearing case No. 598 of 2017 dated 13.10.2017 having CNR No. PBGD-03-002317-2017 titled as Parveen Singh Versus Sanjeev Saini under Section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act. The complaint was filed by respondent No.2.

The allegation in the complaint is that one cheque of Rs.25,000/- issued by the petitioner was dishonored.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner was never actually served in the said case. He has annexed zimni orders to substantiate his assertion. He states that it can never be the intention of the petitioner not to appear before the trial Court. The case is fixed before the trial Court for

The petitioner may appear before the trial Court on or before 27.01.2020. On doing so, he shall be enlarged on bail by the trial Court subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction. Till then, he shall not be arrested. This shall be subject to payment of costs of Rs.2000/- to be paid to the complainant.

The petitioner shall also file an undertaking before the concerned Court that he shall attend the trial on each and every date, without any default.
