Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 17.12.2019, in this regard to the Senior Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

The petitioners have placed on record the copies of Aadhar Cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) as proof of their age as well as certificate (Annexure P3) and photographs (Annexure P4) regarding performance of marriage.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhina, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 17.12.2019, and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
