**CM-12537-CI-2018 in RFA-1788-2017 and CM-12536-CI-
2018 in RFA-1795-2017 have been filed for releasing the amount of
compensation as ordered by the Apex Court on 12.07.2018/20.07.2018.
On 20.02.2019, the following order was passed:-**

**“Counsel for the appellants has furnished a chart prepared
by the appellants showing the shares of the amounts payable to
the landowners to be distributed to them in compliance to the
order of the Supreme Court.**

**Counsel for the landowners further submits that the office
is suggesting for furnishing of Bank Guarantee/Fixed Deposit
against 75% of the amount which is to be released on furnishing
of securities. He accordingly submits that this would practically
amount to non-release of the amount as landowners have lost
their land and it is not practical and feasible to furnish such
securities. Accordingly, office shall give a report as to in what
terms the securities are liable to be furnished by the landowners
for getting the amounts released. Necessary report be filed on or
before the next date.**

Adjourned to 06.03.2019.

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As per above said order dated 20.02.2019, the Registrar General has directed that the Security in the shape of FD/property of the same amount is being obtained for releasing the amount. It is for the beneficiaries, in case they cannot submit security, then on their behalf such securities/surety are being provided by his relatives/family friends. The order passed by the Registrar General reads as under:-

“That at present in such cases, securities in the shape of FD/property of the same amount, which are to be released in favour of beneficiary, are being obtained from the beneficiary, as in case, if beneficiary loses his/her case and he/she may not deposit the amount, which have been received by him/her with the concerned authority, the Court concerned may recover the said amount from the said FD/property, which he/she furnishes as security, by making peshi report. In case beneficiaries cannot submit security then on behalf of beneficiary such securities/surety is/are being provided by his relatives/family friend.”

Resultantly, no further orders are called for, in such circumstances.

IOINs stand disposed of.
