[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to reappoint the petitioner on the vacant post of Edusat Chowkidar in Government Primary School, Ajimpur.

[2] Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was appointed as Edusat Chowkidar in Government Primary School, Ajimpur in the year 2007 and continued as such till the year 2015. Whereupon, due to merger of Government Primary School, Ajimpur with Government Senior Secondary School, Sohansara, the services of the petitioner were dispensed with. Now in July, 2017, the Government Primary School, Ajimpur has again become functional and the other staff along with the petitioner, whose services were dispensed with at the time of merger of Government Primary School, Ajimpur with Government Senior Secondary School, Sohansara have been taken back in service, but the claim of the petitioner for being reappointed on the vacant post of Edusat Chowkidar in restarted Government Primary School, Ajimpur

has not been considered despite representations (Annexure P-5) colly. dated 23.02.2018 and 21.02.2019.

[3] Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representations (Annexure P-5) colly. 23.02.2018 and 21.02.2019, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

[4] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representations (Annexure P-5) colly. dated 23.02.2018 and 21.02.2019, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
