On instructions from SI Sarwan Ram from Police Station Women, Sector 17, Chandigarh, learned counsel for respondents no.1 to 4 submits that in compliance of earlier order dated 06.12.2018 passed in CRM M-34053 of 2018 (Annexure P/3), petitioner has handed over the articles detailed in the list handed over to the police by the petitioner.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the parties and perusal of the record, present petition stands disposed of with the directions to the official respondents to ensure that they do not unduly harass the petitioner or his family members by repeatedly calling them in Police Station. In case, they are still required for the purpose of investigation, seven days clear notice be given to the petitioner in writing to enable them to have legal recourse. It is further directed that official respondent /

concerned authority shall consider representation dated 07.12.2018 (Annexure P/4) moved by the petitioner by passing a speaking order in accordance with law expeditiously.
