The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the official respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners and not to interfere in the personal lives of the petitioners at the behest of respondents No.5 to 7.

Both the petitioners are present in person and identified by their counsel. They seek protection of their life and liberty by contending that both of them having attained the age of majority, have married each other against the wishes of their respective family members/respondents No.4 to 7. To seek appropriate protection from the authorities, they claimed to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) in this regard to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala on 17.12.2019. But they are still apprehensive about their safety and security; in view of the alleged inaction of the police and the alleged clout of their family members/respondents.
