Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that while the petitioner was in service, she was entitled for travelling allowances, for which she had submitted the bills starting from March, 2011 till June, 2018, but the same have not been considered and released by the respondents and as of now, approximately ₹1,10,000/- is due in this regard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that even the medical bills amounting to ₹21,065/- has not been reimbursed to the petitioner without any valid justification. Prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to release the travelling allowance bills as well as reimbursement of the medical bills forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief,

which is being claimed by the petitioner in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted the representations dated 06.10.2019 and 09.09.2019 (Annexures P-3 and P-5) respectively, which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representations.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representations dated 06.10.2019 and 09.09.2019 (Annexures P-3 and P-5 respectively), by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to her within a period of three months thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
