Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 04.12.2019 issued vide order dated 22.11.2019 (Annexure P-14) whereby charge sheet has been issued to the petitioner under Rule 8 of the Punjab Civil Service (P&A) Rules, 1970 and directing the respondents to drop the charge sheet and stay further proceedings in the impugned charge sheet.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if his representation dated 26.08.2019 contained at Annexure P-3 is disposed of and he be allowed to file the response to the charge sheet dated 04.12.2019 after supplying the documents as required. Till then no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of the petition, Ms.Monica Chhibber Sharma, Sr.DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 26.08.2019 contained at Annexure P-13 and supply the requisite documents in accordance with law and petitioner shall be accorded two weeks' time to file response to the charge sheet. Till the time appropriate orders are passed thereupon, no coercive steps shall be taken against the petitioner qua the charge sheet.
