In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that his pension has been wrongly fixed ignoring the Circular dated 13.04.2010 (Annexure P/3), which has been issued by the respondents, according to which, pension of the petitioner cannot be less than 50% of the minimum of the pay scale plus pay band, whereas, the petitioner has been getting pension, which is less than 50% of the minimum of the pay scale plus pay band granted to the post, from which the petitioner superannuated. Prayer of the petitioner is for grant of benefit of Circular dated 13.04.2010 (Annexure P/3) with consequential benefits of arrears alongwith interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 16.11.2019 (Annexure P/15) ,

which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 16.11.2019 (Annexure P/15) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to him within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
