

JYOTI AND ANR. V/S STATE OF HARYANA AND ORS

Present: None for the petitioners.

Mr. Nischal Mann, DAG, Haryana.

This petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners and was disposed of on 14.08.2018.

On 13.12.2018, following order was passed:-

“On 14.08.2018, this petition was disposed off by issuance of a direction to the official respondents to examine the representation of the petitioners, who had entered into marriage and provide them the necessary protection in case of existence of the alleged threat. At the same time, a direction was issued to petitioner No.2 namely Deepak son of Dalbir Singh that he shall deposit a sum of Rs.3 lakhs in the name of petitioner No.1 within a period of three months from the date of order.

Since the compliance was not made by petitioner No.2, the matter was listed before the Court on 03.12.2018. On that date, notice was issued to petitioner No.2. In response to the said order, the counsel as well as petitioner No.2 are present in Court.

In response to the query put by the Court to Deepak son of Dalbir Singh, who apprised the Court that petitioner No.1 has left his company few days after the

order dated 14.08.2018 was passed. Besides, it is also stated that he is employed in the office of a property dealer and is earning a monthly salary of Rs.7,000/- and, therefore, he is unable to arrange the amount as directed by this Court vide order dated 14.08.2018.

State of Haryana is directed to ascertain the fact of the separation as stated by petitioner No.2 and an affidavit in this regard be filed before the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 16.01.2019.”

Status report by way of affidavit of Ram Bhaj, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Jind on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed along with the statements of the petitioners. The same are taken on record.

In the status report, it is mentioned that both the petitioners are residing separately in New Krishna Colony, Jind. Both the petitioners in their statements also mentioned that they are residing separately from each other.

In view of the above, the order dated 14.08.2018 is recalled and petition is dismissed.
