Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the complaint of the private respondents an FIR No.254 dated 9.7.2019, was registered at Police Station Matlauda, District Panipat, under Sections 323, 376, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989. After investigation, the police filed a cancellation report. Now, the private respondents have again made another complaint on the basis of earlier allegations. A representation dated 10.12.2019 (Annexure P3) has been submitted by the petitioner, but the police has not taken any action thereupon.

Mr. Parveen K. Aggarwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2. Let three copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.3 and 4, at this stage.

The petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to objectively consider the representation 10.12.2019 (Annexure P3) and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, in case it is felt necessary, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
