Present petition has been filed by petitioner, namely, Wazid, *inter aila*, praying for a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 & 3 to release or produce the detenues mentioned in para no.2 of the present petition, who are allegedly in the illegal custody of respondents No. 4 & 5.

In this case, on 19.12.2019, following order was passed:-

“This petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 & 3 to release or produce the detenues mentioned in para no.2 of the petition, who are allegedly in the illegal custody of respondents No. 4 & 5.

The petitioner is working at Brick Kiln under the name and style of Sapna Bricks Industries situated in the area of Village Mathana, P.S. Pipli, District Krukshetra Haryana. The persons mentioned in para no.2 of this petition are illegally detained by respondents No. 4 and 5 and they have not been paid their wages.

Keeping in view the allegations of the petitioner, the Registry is directed to appoint a Warrant Officer to visit the Brick Kiln under the name and style of Sapna Bricks Industries situated

in the area of Village Mathana, P.S. Pipli, District Krukshetra Haryana or to any other place to be pointed out by the petitioner and to get the detenues released. Respondents No. 2 & 3 are directed to co-operate with the Warrant Officer and provide necessary police help enabling him to get the detenues released. The expenses of the Warrant Officer shall be met by the petitioner as per the rules. The Warrant Officer shall submit his report well before the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 24.12.2019.”

Pursuant to the aforesaid order passed by this Court, a detailed report dated 21.12.2019 has been filed by the Warrant Officer. The same is ordered to be kept in record.

At this stage, Mr.Aditya Pratap Singh, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners fairly makes a statement that this petition has become infructuous as the detenues have already been released.

In view of the above, no order is required to be passed in this petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
