The present petition has been filed by the petitioner/Ablu Hasan @ Kala, *inter alia* praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus, directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to release the detenues.

On 19.12.2019, this Court had passed the following order:-

“The petitioner is seeking a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for the release of the alleged detenues as described in Para 3 of the petition, who are allegedly detained by the private respondents.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Senior DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and prays for time to seek instructions.

Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State

counsel during the course of the day.

List on 24.12.2019.

Respondent No.2 is directed to personally look into the allegations made in the petition and file an affidavit by the next date of hearing.”

Short reply by way of affidavit of Sandeep Hans, IAS, District Magistrate, Moga, District Moga, on behalf of respondent No.2 has been filed in the Court and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly contends that the detenues have been released.

No further orders are called for.

Disposed of accordingly.
