HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioner No.1 Amandeep Kaur was earlier married on 16.01.2011 to one Gurjant Singh. The petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act for dissolution of their marriage has been filed before the Ld. District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib, which is fixed on 18.05.2020, for second motion.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioners are having live-in-relationship and private respondents who are parents of the petitioners are not happy with their live-in-relationship and they are given threat to them with dire consequences. In this regard, the petitioners have submitted representation dated 19.12.2019 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2, seeking protection of their lives and liberty.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in **Lata Singh Versus State of U.P. And another, 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478**, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
