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It is pointed out that Sohan Lal, taking whose reversion into account, the LPA filed by the appellant Suresh Pal has been dismissed, has now filed a petition challenging his reversion, which is registered as Civil Writ Petition No.13965 of 2018, in which this Court has granted stay of the order of reversion on 29.05.2018, which fact is being placed before this Court vide CM No. 3278-LPA of 2018 in LPA No.574 of 2018 for the purpose of reviewing the order dismissing his appeal and thereafter decide it on merits.

Looking to this subsequent development, the application filed by the applicant-appellant for review is disposed of granting liberty to the applicant-appellant to take up fresh proceedings, if so advised or required, after decision of the writ petition filed by Sohan Lal. It is made clear that the applicant would be at liberty to take up all issues that may arise on account of the petition filed by Sohan Lal being allowed. The applicant-appellant is also granted liberty to intervene in the petition filed by Sohan Lal by filing an appropriate application.

With the aforesaid observations and liberty, the application for review is disposed of.
