Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are major and have got married against the wishes of their parents and relatives. They have been receiving serious threats after their marriage and apprehend grave danger to their life and liberty. The petitioners have also sent a representation (Annexure P-6) in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab, but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to the veracity of the contents of the petition and the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior

Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, Punjab, to consider the representation (Annexure P-6) and take necessary action as per law expeditiously.

It is, however, made clear that this order shall not, in any manner, be construed as an expression of opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners and shall have no effect on civil or criminal proceedings, if any, instituted/pending against them.
