GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The Present petition has been filed by the petitioners/Simranpreet Kaur and Vishandeep Singh, *inter alia* praying for directions to the official respondents No.2 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and not to interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard a detailed representation dated 22.12.2019 (Annexure P-4), has been submitted to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned with the above representation, with regard to their alleged threat

perception, the same shall be got examined by Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran (respondent No.2), expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

It is, however, clarified that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.
