Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation(Annexure P-5) dated 27.12.2019 in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Randhir Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioners have placed on record copies of Aadhar Cards of petitioners No.1 and 2(Annexures P-1 and P-2) and the petitioners have also produced on record copy of their marriage certificate(Annexure P-4) and photographs (Annexure P-3).

During the Course of hearing, the petitioners have also placed on record copies of their PAN cards in support of their age proof. The same are taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 27.12.2019 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
