At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioner submits that respondent no.2 may be directed to return the dowry articles as

Accordingly, I hereby direct the respondent no.2 to return the dowry articles within three weeks from today to the police station Model Town and on receipt of the dowry articles, the same shall be returned to the complainant/petitioner.

The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
