This application has been filed by the petitioner praying for modification of the order dated 12.12.2019 passed by this Court to the limited extent that the said order had recorded that the petitioner shall be at liberty to apply for visa afresh.

It is contended that the petitioner had already been granted a visa which is valid till 11.10.2025 and therefore, need not apply for a fresh visa.
