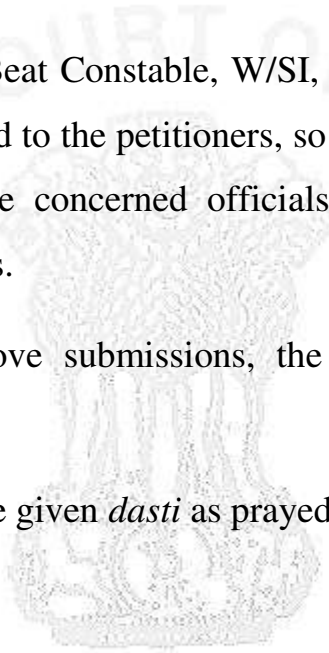
Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
