1. Notice. Mr Akshay Makhija, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the Respondents / UOI.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the Respondents informs the Court that the Petitioner's 'Redressal of Grievance' ('RoG') raised on 20th November, 2018 is being treated as an application under Section 163 of the Navy Act, 1957.
